## ADS2 Lab Etiquette

- Please do not eat or drink in the lab.
- If you are in a RED lab group please sit at RED workstations. If all RED workstations are taken, move to a YELLOW workstation.
- If you are in a BLUE lab group please sit at BLUE workstations. If all BLUE workstations are taken, move to a YELLOW workstation.
